4-H Camp Shankitunk is located on 145 acres of county owned land along the west branch of the Delaware River between Delancey & Delhi. The main campground is a large open meadow surrounded by naturally wooded hillsides. Campers are housed in cabins spaced among the trees and along the meadow's edge.

4-H Camp Shankitunk is available for rent by any responsible group.

With overnight accommodations for up to 150 people, including sleeping quarters, kitchen and dining facilities, indoor and outdoor activity spaces, and restrooms. Don't need the entire facility? We can customize a package just for you.

Groups wishing to rent the camp must sign a written agreement covering the use of the camp and provide certificate of insurance. For more information or to schedule your rental today, contact the 4-H Camp Administrative Assistant at 607-865-6531.

**Comprehensive General Liability** – rental groups must provide coverage with a minimum combined single limit per occurrence of \$1,000,000.00. If the general liability is from a policy of insurance commonly known as Business Owners Policy (BOP), the Certificate must indicate that the liability insurance provided under the BOP is primary for this event.

**Facilities** - Groups may rent the entire camp facility for a cost of \$1,100.00 per day. Smaller groups may rent portions of the camp based on their needs. The schedule below provides information regarding rental of individual facilities at camp.

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Ropes Course Rental: four hours - maximum of 15 people: \$50

\*Note that certified lifeguards are required and we can arrange for that if needed at \$30.00 an hour for pool director/lifeguard and one other lifeguard. Two lifeguards for the first 25 swimmers. Additional lifeguard (\$20 per hour) required for each additional 25 swimmers. Rental groups may provide their own lifeguards if they meet New York State Department of Health and 4-H Camp Shankitunk requirements.

- Full camp rental includes the ropes facilities but not the facilitators. All ropes course facilitators at Camp Shankitunk must be on our list of approved facilitators.
- The staff of Camp Shankitunk tries to make your stay as enjoyable as possible. Most of our camp maintenance and construction is done off season. We reserve the right however to do maintenance and construction as needed.
- Camp Shankitunk's rental season begins April 1st and ends November 30<sup>th</sup>.

## Staff on Site

Groups renting the pool are required to have lifeguards on site. 4-H Camp Shankitunk can provide lifeguards. Rental groups may choose to provide their own lifeguards, provided that they meet the minimum qualifications stated by New York State Department of Health.

- ◆ 2 lifeguards on duty for the first 25 bathers
- ◆ Rental groups must provide one adult (18 or older) to supervise each 25 bathers
- ◆ Rental groups may use their own lifeguards if they meet New York State

Department of Health and 4-H Camp Shankitunk requirements (e.g. WSI, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Basic Lifeguard)

4-H Camp Shankitunk provides a caretaker to open and close the premises and to be on call in case of emergency. Renting groups are expected to use reasonable care and caution in the use of property and equipment and are responsible for all damages.
